M.G.L. c. 55 places certain requirements on political action committees which are not placed on "People's Committees." These include but are not necessarily limited to:

(i) s. 5 requires that the name of a political action committee include the words "Political Action Committee" in said name.

- (ii) s. 5A states that no candidate or individual holding elective public office shall establish, finance, maintain, control or serve as a principal officer of a political action committee.
- (iii) s. 6A places limits on the aggregate amount of contributions certain candidates can accept from political action committees in a calendar year. When a political action committee makes a contribution to a candidate or a candidate's committee it must be made in the name of the political action committee.
