Who files the pre-preliminary report?

Pre-preliminary reports are only due from candidates when their names appear on the preliminary ballot. If a candidate's name does not appear on a preliminary ballot, the pre-preliminary report is not filed. At least four preliminary election dates are being used for fall elections in 2019. These are the preliminary reporting dates for candidates who appear on the preliminary ballot:

Preliminary Election	Reporting Dates	Pre-Preliminary Due
1. Sept. 10	Jan. 1 to Aug. 23	Sept. 3
2. Sept. 17	Jan. 1 to Aug. 30	Sept. 9

RECENT QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FROM CLERKS AND LOCAL ELECTION OFFICIALS

Q: Is a candidate required to file a M101 organizational form?

A: OCPF encourages all candidates to file the M101. However, if a candidate is running by himself or herself, and does not have a committee, the M101 is not required. For example, a candidate who only uses his personal funds may decide not to file the M101.

Q: A candidate will have an event at a local restaurant, which is organized as a LLC. The owner wants to give free drinks to the first 20 attendees. OK?

A: It's not OK unless the candidate pays the restaurant for the 20 drinks. LLCs are prohibited from providing goods for free to committees.

Q: Can a candidate use a function room at the town library for a meet and greet campaign event?

A: Yes, so long as there is no fundraising, and equal access is granted to all candidates under the same terms and conditions.
