
A LOOK AHEAD:






Your candidates and committees may make mistakes on their M102 campaign finance forms.

When an error is discovered, the committee can use the M102A form to resolve the issue. Click the image above for a 2-minute tutorial.

REMINDER: There's a new form for local candidates with no activity



The M109 form can be used by local filers without committees who don't raise or spend money, have no liabilities or in-kind contributions, and have no balances. It is filed just once a year.

We designed this form with town elections in mind, after hearing from clerks that there is no fundraising or spending in some small communities.
