
Mike Sullivan retires

OCPF Director Michael Sullivan retired on Dec. 27, but will remain with the agency in a consulting capacity to assist with implementing new <u>campaign finance legislation</u>.

Sullivan was first appointed in 1994. Prior to working at OCPF, Mike was the Newburyport city clerk.

A commission consisting of the secretary of state, the chairs of the Democratic and Republican parties, and a law school dean appointed by the governor, will appoint a new director. Directors serve six-year terms.
