Who files the year-end report?

The year-end report is filed by every elected officeholder in your city or town, as well as every nonincumbent with activity, a balance or liabilities. Nonincumbents can include former office-holders, unsuccessful candidates, and future candidates who have organized.

The M102 campaign finance form is available <u>here</u>. Due to a holiday, the report is due Jan. 22, 2019.

New e-filing system

OCPF has created a new web-based filing system that can be used by local filers to create, print and file paper reports with your office.

Reporter 7 will be available after the Nov. 6 election. Currently, more than 300 local candidates use Reporter 6 (the current system) to create and file reports. Candidates who are already organized to use Reporter 6 will automatically migrate to Reporter 7.

To use Reporter 7, a candidate only needs to send his or her organizational form (M101) to Jason Tait at OCPF (jtait@cpf.state.ma.us).

Candidates can scan and e-mail their reports
