**OCPF Releases Senate Spending Figures
for 1990 Election**

The Office of Campaign and Political Finance today released figures on the total amount of money raised and spent in the 40 State Senate races during the 1990 election season.

"This is the first time the Office has compiled this information on campaign finance activities in the Massachusetts Senate campaigns", said Mary F. McTigue, Director of the Office. "Regardless of which office you look at, whether it's the campaign for statewide office or the State Senate, 1990 was a very expensive election year in Massachusetts", McTigue said.

Candidates had a total of \$2,456,899 in beginning balances at the start of the 1990 election cycle. The 106 Senate candidates raised a total of \$4,530,863 in 1990, bringing the total monies available to \$6,987,762.

Money spent by these candidates for the Massachusetts Senate totaled \$5,060,968.

The study also identifies that the most expensive race for a Senate seat was the 3rd Middlesex District, with 7 candidates spending a total of \$505,056 during 1990. In addition, the least expensive contested campaign for the Senate was the Plymouth district, with two candidates spending a total of \$28,932.

A breakdown of spending by party affiliation indicates that the democrats outspent the republicans in the Senate races by more than a 2.5 to 1 margin. Total spending by the 57 democratic candidates was \$3,613,528.

44 Republican Senate candidates spent a total of \$1,431,066. The 5 candidates with other party affiliations spent a total of \$16,373. Viewed on a per-candidate basis, the average democratic candidate spent \$63,395, the average republican candidate spent \$32,524 and the other 5 candidates spent an average of \$3,275 each.

Only 5 of the 40 Senate seats were uncontested in 1990. These 5 candidates spent a total of \$183,293 with 2 of the candidates spending in excess of \$50,000 each.

Of the remaining 35 contested races, a total of \$4,877,674 was spent during the 1990 election. This

represents an average amount spent of \$139,362 per race for a contested seat. In 25 of the 35 contested races, the individual who spent the most money was elected.

Other figures contained in the report analyze the seven "open" seats in the Senate. A total of \$1,711,605 was spent in these races. Average expenditures for an open seat in the 1990 election was \$244,515 with a range of spending from \$107,280 for the Middlesex Worcester District to a high of \$505,056 in the 3rd Middlesex District.

The enclosed tables reflect spending by individual senatorial candidates in each district and other statistics compiled by the Office based on reports filed as of January 31, 1991.

The Office of Campaign and Political Finance was established in 1973 to monitor the campaign finance activities of all candidates on the state, county and municipal level. OCPF maintains the campaign finance records for all candidates in order to provide disclosure of these activities to the public.

**OCPF RELEASES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
SPENDING FIGURES FOR 1990 ELECTION**

The Office of Campaign and Political Finance today released figures on the total amount of money raised and spent by candidates for the 160 seats in the House of Representatives during the 1990 statewide election.

The 401 House candidates raised \$6,787,691 during calendar year 1990. This figure, when added to the combined balances of \$2,217,037 carried over from previous years, provided a total of \$9,004,728 available for election-related expenditures. Total spending for all House seats amounted to \$7,129,457.

A breakdown of spending by party affiliation indicates that Democrats outspent Republicans in House races by more than a 3 to 1 margin. OCPF reported that the total spent by

the 226 Democratic candidates was \$5,376,631 while the 144 Republican candidates spent a total of \$1,589,386. In addition, 31 candidates having other party affiliations spent a total of \$163,440.

OCPF's report also indicates that amounts spent by incumbents and non-incumbents were not significantly different. Incumbents spent a total of \$3,812,666 while non-incumbent candidate spending totaled \$3,316,790. The 10 incumbent and non-incumbent candidates spending the most in their races are listed on the attached sheets. As a whole, successful candidates outspent their opponents by almost 2 to 1, spending \$4,457,187 as compared to \$2,272,270. Also included in the attached information are figures representing the per-candidate spending averages by various categories.

Although 44 of the 160 House seats were uncontested in this last election, \$790,887 of a total \$1,636,996 available was spent by these candidates.

The Office of Campaign and Political Finance was established in 1973 to oversee and enforce the campaign finance laws with respect to all candidates on the state, county and municipal level. In addition, OCPF maintains campaign finance records for all candidates and political committees in order to provide disclosure of these activities to the public.
